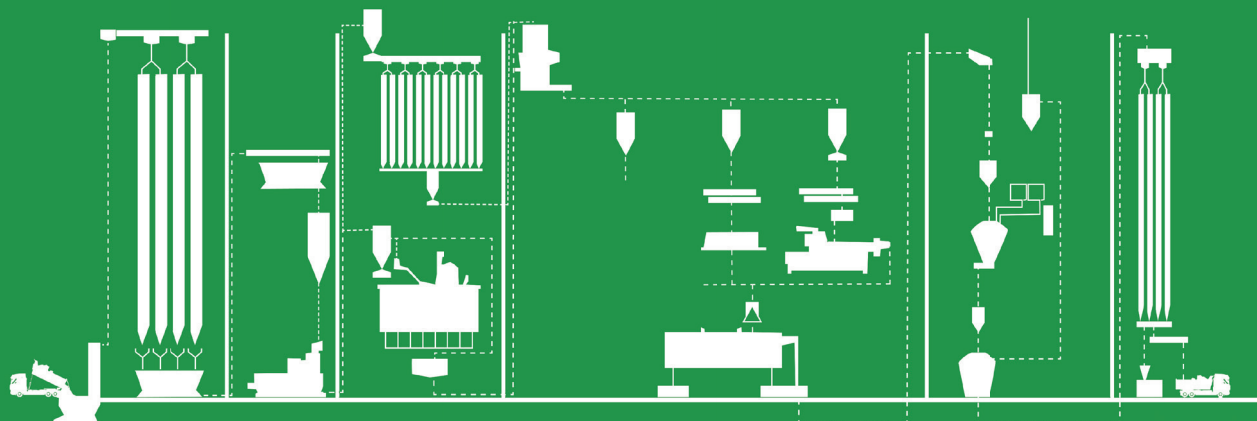

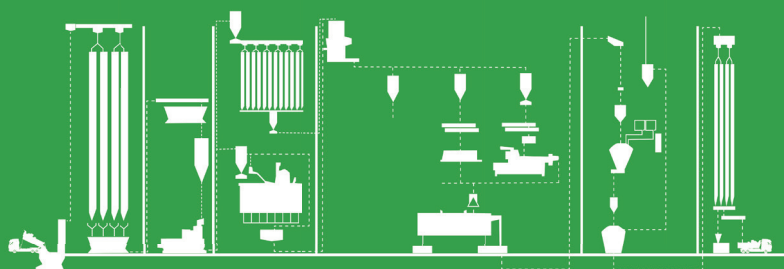

The Role of the Roller Mill in the Feedmill
